Subj: REVISE MISSION STATEMENT FOR NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE GROUP
TEN

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A

1. Purpose. To modify the mission statement of Naval Special Warfare group TEN (NAVSPECWARGRU TEN), per reference (a).
2. Background. In conjunction with an updated mission, functions, and tasks instruction, the official mission statement of NAVSPECWARGRU TEN must also be updated.
3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, the mission statement must read: organize, man, train, educate, equip, support, and deploy specialized capabilities to perform intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance and preparation of the environment activities in support of combatant commanders and other mission partners.
4. Action. Commander, Navy Special Warfare Command will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to issue a revised missions, functions, and tasks directive for NAVSPECWARGRU TEN within 90 days. Distribution of that directive will include Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33).
5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
